AUTHORITY

- **Labelling of textiles for fibre content:**
 - Textile Labelling Act (R.S.C. 1985)
 - Textile Labelling and Advertising Regulations (C.R.C. c. 1551)
- **Regulations for Children’s Sleepwear:**
 - Children’s Sleepwear Regulations (SOR/2016-169) under the Canada Consumer Product Safety Act

COVERAGE

The basic requirements state that any item made in whole or in part from a textile fiber, yarn or fabric must have attached a label that discloses the fiber content information in both English and French.
