Mandatory Standard

CLASS: Personal Care Products

AUTHORITY

Under the *Food and Drugs Act*, a cosmetic includes "any substance or mixture of substances manufactured, sold or represented for use in cleansing, improving or altering the complexion, skin, hair or teeth and includes deodorants and perfumes." This includes "handmade" cosmetics sold at craft sales.

- Making cosmetics is covered under the Food and Drugs Act and the Cosmetic Regulations
- Labelling and packaging is covered under:
 Cosmetic Regulations under the Food and Drugs Act and
 Consumer Packaging and Labelling Regulations under the Consumer Packaging and
 Labelling Act

COVERAGE

- Homemade cosmetics sold at craft sales and home businesses.
- Does not include non-prescription drugs or natural health care products
